1. BACKGROUND NEEDS FOR CAPACITY BUILDING



- ❑ Prior to 2017, SIA was done as part of the environmental impact assessment (EIA) process.
- ❑ SIA is a growing and evolving practice inline with urbanization and expectations of the multiracial community, and so is the regulation of development and infrastructure projects
- ❑ Social issues and impacts currently need to be examined in greater depth and reviewed with greater scrutiny.
- ❑ Hence, there is a sharp rise in the demand for professionals to undertake quality SIA since 2017

The Malaysian Association of Social Impact Assessment (MSIA) was established under the Registrar of Societies Malaysia on 15th March 2005.


MSIA is an association of multi-disciplinary professionals, open to all Malaysians from various fields :
