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## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE AND PROJECT HIGHLIGHT

Yang Berbahagia Datuk TPr Dr. Alias bin Rameli, Ketua Pengarah PLANMalaysia dan dif-dif jemputan, Puan Sri, Datuk-Datuk, Datin-Datin, Profesor-Profesor, Dr.-Dr., tuan-tuan dan puan-puan yang dihormati sekalian serta para ahli Pertubuhan Penilaian Impak Sosial Malaysia (MSIA) yang saya kasihi.

Dengan penuh rasa syukur, saya mengalu-alukan kehadiran semua ke Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan MSIA kali ke-20 yang diadakan secara *hybrid* pada hari ini. Mesyuarat kali ini juga menandakan berakhirnya penggal perkhidmatan Jawatankuasa Eksekutif MSIA sesi 2023–2025. Dengan penuh rasa rendah hati, saya juga mengucapkan terima kasih atas kepercayaan yang telah diberikan kepada saya untuk memimpin MSIA selama tiga penggal. Dalam tempoh ini, kita telah menyaksikan perkembangan yang boleh kita banggakan. Pertubuhan ini telah semakin dikenali, dihormati, dan terus memainkan peranan penting dalam mengarusperdanakan SIA dalam dasar awam dan amalan pembangunan di pelbagai peringkat.

Selaras dengan sambutan MSIA 20 Tahun; 2005-2025, saya ingin merakamkan penghargaan kepada semua yang telah meninggalkan belang dan jejak-jejak bakti kepada perkembangan SIA di negara ini. Bersama-sama PLANMalaysia, MSIA telah 2 dekad meneraju, memperjuangkan dan mengangkat pertanggungjawaban SIA untuk projek pembangunan. 20 tahun MSIA telah *spearhead* dan menjadi *champion* kepada kepentingan SIA di Malaysia.

Jejak bakti dan cabaran ke arah masa depan

Dimulakan dengan langkah-langkah awal berani oleh mantan-mantan pengarah dan pegawai Jabatan Perancangan Bandar dan Desa, termasuklah daripada awal penubuhan seperti En Kamalruddin bin Shamsuddin, Datin Paduka TPr Dr. Dahlia binti Rosly, Dato' TPr Dr. Dolbani bin Mijan, TPr Jasmiah binti Ismail dan lain-lain yang ramai tidak dapat disebutkan di sini, sehinggalah kini setelah kepimpinan PLANMalaysia diterajui oleh Datuk KP Dr. Alias bin Rameli, MSIA telah sama-sama mengatur langkah sederhana seiring dengan jabatan di dalam usaha meningkatkan *social safeguarding* di negara ini.

Kini, kita bersedia melangkah ke fasa seterusnya dengan semangat yang lebih segar dan wawasan yang lebih luas. Dunia pembangunan kini berubah pantas — dengan cabaran baharu, keperluan komuniti yang semakin kompleks, serta keperluan menyeimbangkan kemajuan fizikal dengan kesejahteraan sosial dan kelestarian nilai kemanusiaan.

Sebagai sebuah pertubuhan yang menjadi suara kepada para pengamal Penilaian Impak Sosial, kita perlu terus ke hadapan — membina kapasiti, meningkatkan *visibility*, memperluas jaringan strategik, dan memastikan bahawa prinsip-prinsip keadilan sosial, inklusiviti dan keterlibatan awam terus menjadi teras kepada setiap projek pembangunan. Kita akan terus melangkah ke hadapan sebagai untuk memastikan SIA diarusperdanakan mencapai pembentukan komuniti madani, inklusif dan bahagia.

**Menjaga kesejahteraan komuniti** — akan terus menjadi misi dan tunjang segala gerak kerja MSIA. Kita percaya bahawa Penilaian Impak Sosial (SIA) hanya akan benar-benar memberi impak apabila ia difahami, diterima, dan diamalkan secara meluas, merentas sektor dan lapisan masyarakat, juga dalam semua peringkat perancangan dan pembangunan tanah, pembinaan, operasi dan pengabaian. Pengukuhan SIA dalam pembuatan program dan dasar juga perlu terus diperkukuhkan bukan hanya pada saat terakhir, iaitu pembangunan projek.

Sebagai badan peneraju dalam bidang ini, MSIA berbangga kerana dari sejumlah 264 ahli, kini memiliki **42** orang ahli profesional dan **71** orang **(67%)** yang telah berdaftar dari **sejumlah 106** secara rasmi sebagai penyedia dan penilai SIA dengan PLANMalaysia. Ini adalah satu pencapaian yang membuktikan kesungguhan kita dalam memperkukuh keupayaan sumber manusia tempatan yang berkompeten dan berintegriti di MSIA tepat dengan keperluan dan perkembangan terkini.

Seperti yang kita telah rancangkan sepanjang 2023-2025, kita telah berusaha melaksanakan sasaran projek dan program ke arah pencapaian matlamat dan objektif yang dirangka di bawah MSIA Vision Framework 2030.

Objektif **Memperkasa Keupayaan** merupakan objektif dan agenda utama MSIA. Jumlah kursus SIA yang dianjurkan terus meningkat, dengan adanya permohonan untuk mengadakan kursus-kursus seumpama dari GLC utama seperti PETRONAS, dari agensi, malah dari pihak institusi kewangan juga. Kita bukan hanya membangunkan kecekapan ahli MSIA dalam melaksanakan SIA, malah pihak komuniti professional dan komuniti *business* di luar sana, termasuk dari Wilayah Sabah dan Sarawak.

Di dalam objektif **Memajukan Sains dan Amalan SIA**, melalui usaha-usaha MoU dengan pelbagai pihak, termasuk dengan IPT Awam, kita telah mula membangunkan alat, teknologi metodologi dan pendekatan saintifik yang inovatif bagi meningkatkan ketepatan dan keberkesanan Penilaian Impak Sosial seperti Projek SIRA yang akan kita bentangkan nanti.

Di bawah objektif **Memperkukuh Perlindungan Sosial**, MSIA telah secara proaktif menyokong kerajaan dan institusi dalam merangka serta melaksanakan sistem perlindungan sosial yang kukuh bagi memastikan pembangunan menghormati hak asasi, budaya dan kesejahteraan komuniti termasuklah seperti penyertaan di dalam perundingan RUU Pembaharuan Semula Bandar.

Dan terakhir siri MSIA Talk bulanan dan seminar serta perkongsian ilmu dari rakan-rakan strategik dari dalam dan luar negara terus dipergiatkan untuk memperluas pemahaman awam mengenai kepentingan SIA sebagai alat penting dalam pembangunan yang mampan dan inklusif, merentasi semua lapisan masyarakat. Laporan Tahunan yang akan dibentangkan nanti akan memperincikan projek dan program yang telah kita jayakan.

Sekalung penghargaan kepada barisan EXCO MSIA 2023/2025 kerana telah sama-sama berganding usaha, idea dan komitmen di dalam semua aktiviti MSIA sepanjang tempoh dua tahun yang lalu, termasuklah mereka yang terlibat sebagai panel penilai laporan SIA, juga penghargaan khusus kepada ahli-ahli bukan EXCO yang telah turut serta dalam Jawatankuasa-jawatankuasa MSIA atau menghadiri mesyuarat, perbincangan dan lain-lain aktiviti berkaitan, termasuk aktiviti CSR yang kita telah jayakan.

Projek, program dan sumbangan serta komitmen EXCO dan ahli-ahli

Dengan kesempatan yang ada ini, saya juga ingin sekali menzahirkan penghargaan setinggi-tingginya kepada PLANMalaysia Ibu Pejabat dan PLANMalaysia negeri-negeri kerana telah mengiktiraf peranan MSIA dalam pembangunan SIA di Malaysia. MSIA perlu meneruskan kerjasama erat berterusan dengan PLANMalaysia, serta jabatan dan agensi kerajaan di semua peringkat, termasuk juga GLC dan agensi/ jabatan di Wilayah Sabah dan Sarawak.

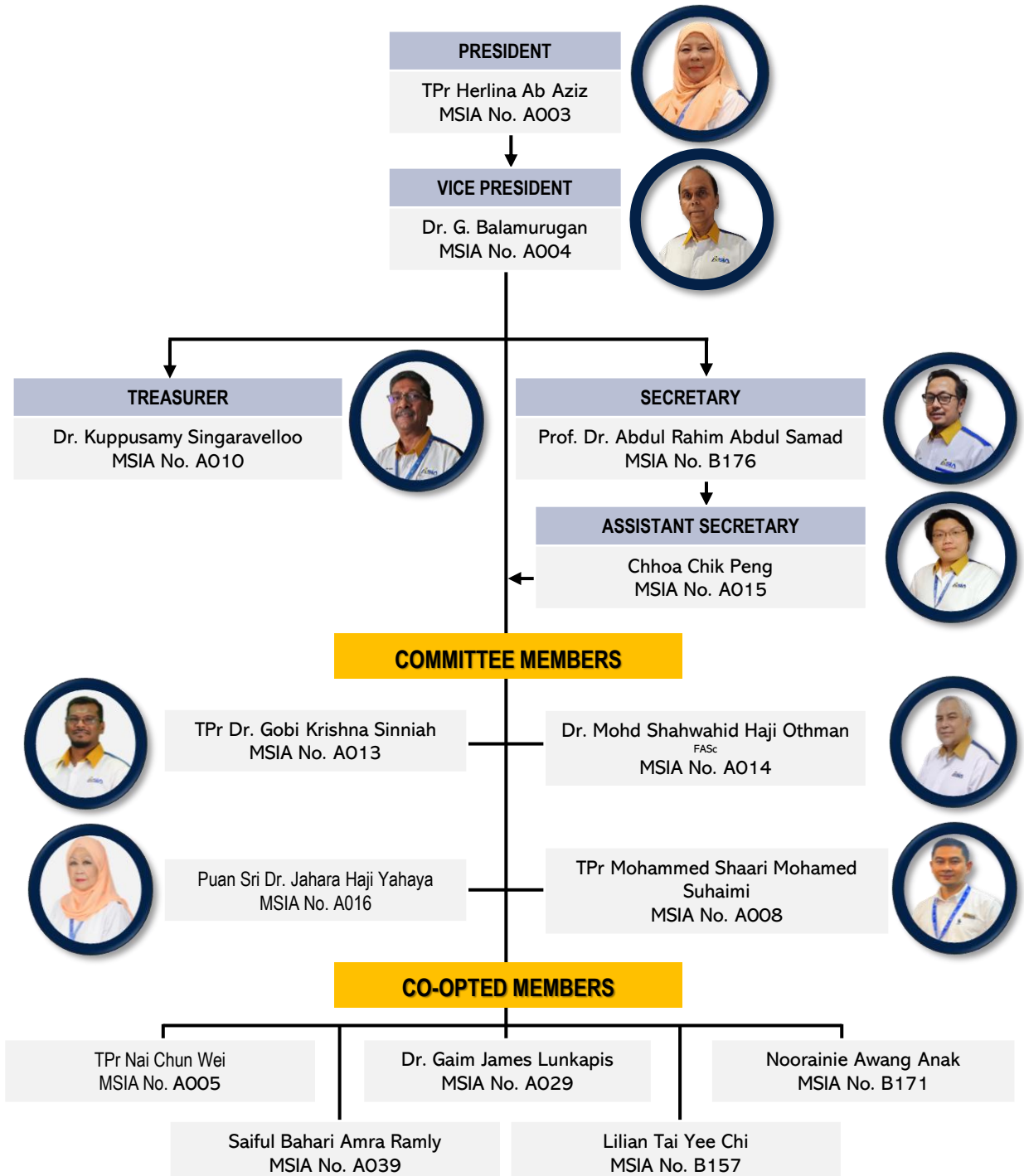

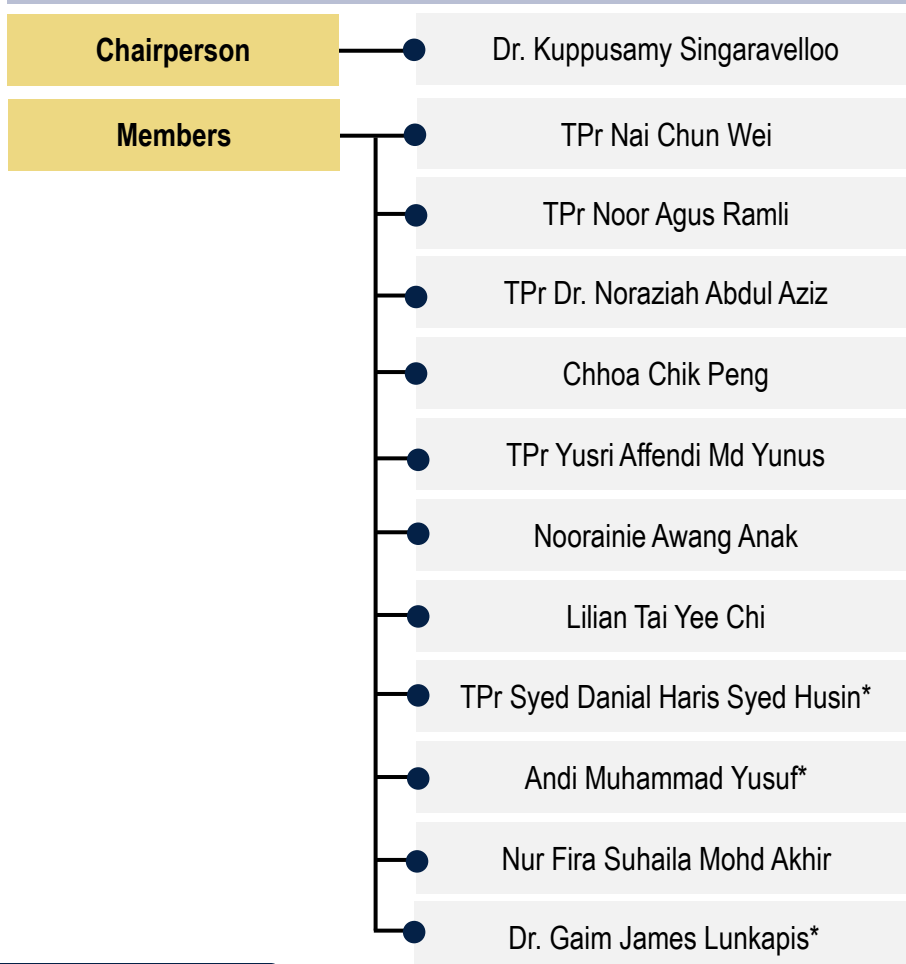

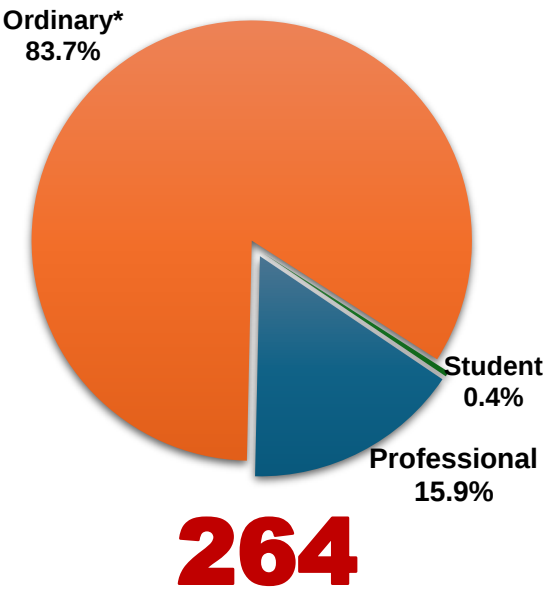

## Ad Hoc Roundtable Consultation Committee on the Draft Urban Renewal Bill (URB)

MSIA, in its commitment to strengthening social safeguards in Malaysia, has established an Ad Hoc Roundtable Consultation Committee under its Technical Committee to review the Draft Urban Renewal Bill (URB), culminating in the submission of a 60-page report to PLANMalaysia on 30 March 2025. Two review sessions were held—first with PLANMalaysia and subsequently by the MSIA Roundtable Committee—comprising professionals with expertise in social impact assessment and urban planning.

## JOINT-RESEARCH PROJECT

MSIA in collaboration with Universiti Sultan Zainal Abidin (UniSZA), Terengganu and PLANMalaysia @Terengganu, is involved in undertaking a joint-research project entitled "Sistem Penilaian Impak Sosial Pantas (SIRA) Sokongan Pembuatan Keputusan Bagi Penentuan Projek Berpotensi, Terengganu "under the Industry Matching Program 2024 (IMAP2024). PEERS Consult (M) Sdn. Bhd., a leading Town and Regional Planning Consultancy, has been selected by UniSZA as its partner industry. The main objectives of the research are as the followings:

- To identify and analyse baseline data and information and to develop a database to assist in informed business decision for potential development projects in Terengganu
- To integrate the baseline data and geospatial data in developing spatial model for a rapid appraisal of SIA parameters in determining development projects
- To provide a decision - support system (DSS) in making better informed decision through early assessment of the significance of any adverse impacts and uncertainties arising from the proposed project

It is envisaged that a tangible deliverable of the research project is the development of a rapid SIA appraisal system or **Sistem Penilaian Impak Sosial Pantas (SIRA)** based on spatial model. SIRA will be essentially be a computerized programme which allows better decision-making with database for the determination and selection of development projects requiring SIA.

## Pembangunan perlu penilaian impak sosial elak berlaku konflik

Banyak kita boleh belajar daripada usaha masyarakat Melayu tradisi Kampung Lama Rempang Galang di Pulau Batam, Indonesia yang cuba mempertahankan tanah leluhur daripada diisir untuk memberi laluan kepada projek memajukan kawasan itu, sekali gus membuka mata terhadap kepentingan penilaian impak sosial dalam pembangunan dan pelaburan negara.

Pulau Rempang Galang ialah sebahagian kawasan yang membentuk Koridor Pembangunan Batam dengan perancangan Projek-Projek Strategik Nasional Indonesia 2023 untuk menjadikannya sebagai pusat industri, perdagangan dan pelancongan. Pengambilan tanah untuk menjalankan pembangunan projek ini menimbulkan konflik besar kerana membabitkan perpindahan keluar penduduk secara paksa. Kelemahan proses perundingan antara kerajaan dan pelabur dengan masyarakat mengakibatkan salah faham dan diskriminasi.

Hakikatnya, proses perundingan seumpama penting dalam penilaian impak sosial (SIA) sebelum projek diluluskan dan dilaksanakan.

SIA adalah proses mengenal pasti dan mengurus impak sosial dijangka berlaku daripada pelaksanaan projek pembangunan. Proses jelas dan terstruktur akan mengenal pasti impak sosial serta go-longan terkesan, mengelak impak dengan melakukan pindaan kepada cadangan projek dan mengurusnya bagi meminimumkan impak negatif di-

jangkakan. Menurut prinsip SIA, perpindahan keluar penduduk daripada tapak projek hanya pilihan terakhir selepas semua langkah mitigasi lain diambil.

Tidak seperti Malaysia yang mewajibkan penyediaan Laporan SIA secara terancang kepada projek berkepentingan negeri dan negara sejak 2017, proses SIA mandatori di Indonesia belum dilaksanakan. Jika ia dilakukan terlebih dahulu, dengan pembabitkan pemegang taruh dan masyarakat terkesan, sudah pasti konflik sedemikian boleh dielakkan.

Terkini di Indonesia, kajian SIA hanya dijalankan sebagai sebahagian proses penilaian alam sekitar (AMDAL) atau dalam keperluan perancangan pengambilan tanah. Namun, pada peringkat pengambilan tanah, sering terlalu lewat untuk berbuat apa-apa langkah mitigasi sosial berkesan dan bantuan penduduk sudah mencapai tahap tertinggi.

### Gagal salur maklumat tepat

Dalam kes Rempang Galang ini, selain kelemahan proses rundingan, kegagalan menyalurkan maklumat mitigasi kepada penduduk juga menimbulkan keresahan memuncak. Cadangan pampasan akan diberi kepada penduduk terkesan, iaitu gantian tanah dan rumah serta perincian lain berkaitan perpindahan tetap meningkatkan kegusaran penduduk terhadap nasib mereka di persekitaran baharu.

Walaupun Presiden Indonesia pernah berjanji semua konsesi tanah kepada pelabur bersengketa dengan rakyat akan dibatalkan, keadaan konflik di Pulau Rempang Galang belum lagi menyaksikan kesediaan pelabur, mahupun pembuat keputusan

di peringkat provinsi untuk berundur daripada meneruskan proses pengusiran.

Semua langkah pengusiran keluar perlu ditangguhkan hingga pihak terkesan berpuas hati dengan pampasan ditawarkan dan bersedia memberi laluan kepada pembangunan di kawasan mereka.

Berbanding kesediaan garis panduan khusus penyediaan SIA di Malaysia, iaitu Panduan Pelaksanaan Penilaian Impak Sosial (PPSIA) oleh Jabatan Perancangan Bandar dan Desa, PLANMalaysia, ketidadaan garis panduan seumpama di Indonesia mengusulkan kerajaan.

Pelbagai peruntukan undang-undang semasa di Indonesia memberi perhatian kepada pengurusan impak sosial secara terampil, namun tidak menjurus khusus kepada peruntukan mandatori penyediaan SIA lebih menyeluruh bagi negara itu.

Perkara ini diadiri kerajaan Indonesia yang mula-mula mengemukakan usaha menyelidiki satu Garis Panduan Teknik Penyediaan SIA Indonesia, dengan kerjasama Bank Dunia. Dengan adanya garis panduan jelas memandu pelaksanaan Kajian SIA bagi negaranya, Indonesia berharap projek berkepentingan negara dapat dilaksanakan dengan jayanya, tanpa tentangan keras penduduk.

Di sebalik kita sudah mempunyai mekanisme lebih baik, Malaysia perlu belajar daripada pengalaman pahit Rempang Galang dengan mengambil langkah memastikan pembangunan dan pelaburan di negara tidak hanya membawa kemakmuran ekonomi, bahkan keadilan sosial kepada rakyat.

Pelabur dan pemuja ke Malaysia juga perlu memahami proses SIA dengan teliti serta menyeluruh adalah penting untuk menjamin kelancaran projek, kedamaian negara dan kebahagiaan rakyat.
